## Florida Mold Law NOW IN EFFECT

Florida's mold-related services law, which went into effect on July 1, 2010, requires that all mold assessors and mold remediators obtain a license to work in the state.

Florida is accepting applications from individuals who are certified as mold assessors by State or national associations that require a proctored examination in mold assessment. These applicants must also submit proof of completion of at least 60 hours of education in mold assessment.
